



AIM Harvest Summary: Weeks of 5/16 and 5/23

3 person crew (2 divers)

Week 1

Small plants all around between 3" to 2' in height. Mostly brown in color but also producing green fragment growth. ½ bag total harvested with a plant count of 328. Big Square, Buck Island, into Sagnina Bay to Barge Bay (first small bay on the North shore of Saginaw), Bay North of Bottleneck and Bottleneck Bay, Fish Creek Bay. Highest level of growth harvested around Buck Island.

Week 2

Plants looking healthier and greener, roughly 4' maximum height. 4 bags harvested with a total of 998 plants. Little Square (2 bags) and Pork Bay (1.5 bags) produced the majority. Other areas covered were, the area w/ transects outside of Donaldson's heading South out of the mouth of Fish Creek Bay, Fish Creek Pond (25 plants total), Gilpin Rock Pile, Eagle Island Rock Pile (S of Island), Island near the Young Life gas dock and Goose Island.

As expected Little Square and Pork Bays are producing the most significant growth. The team will begin working on the southern swims starting with the Gulls in the coming weeks.
