



AIM Harvest Summary: Week of 7/16/12

Began the week in the bay North of Bottleneck where Guy had dropped buoys. Line swam the area removing approximately 150 plants (1/2 bag). Went to the area in front of Camp Wenonah and swam the area around more of Guy's buoys removing 50 plants (1/4 bag). Then went to buoys dropped around Doctor's Island and removed an additional 40 plants (1/4 bag).

Conducted a tight zig-zag pattern swim of Square Bay from shore to drop-off finding 2-4' tall single stem plants. Then moved to Gilpin Bay and removed about 12 plants all 4-6' single stems. (1/4 bag total from both areas).

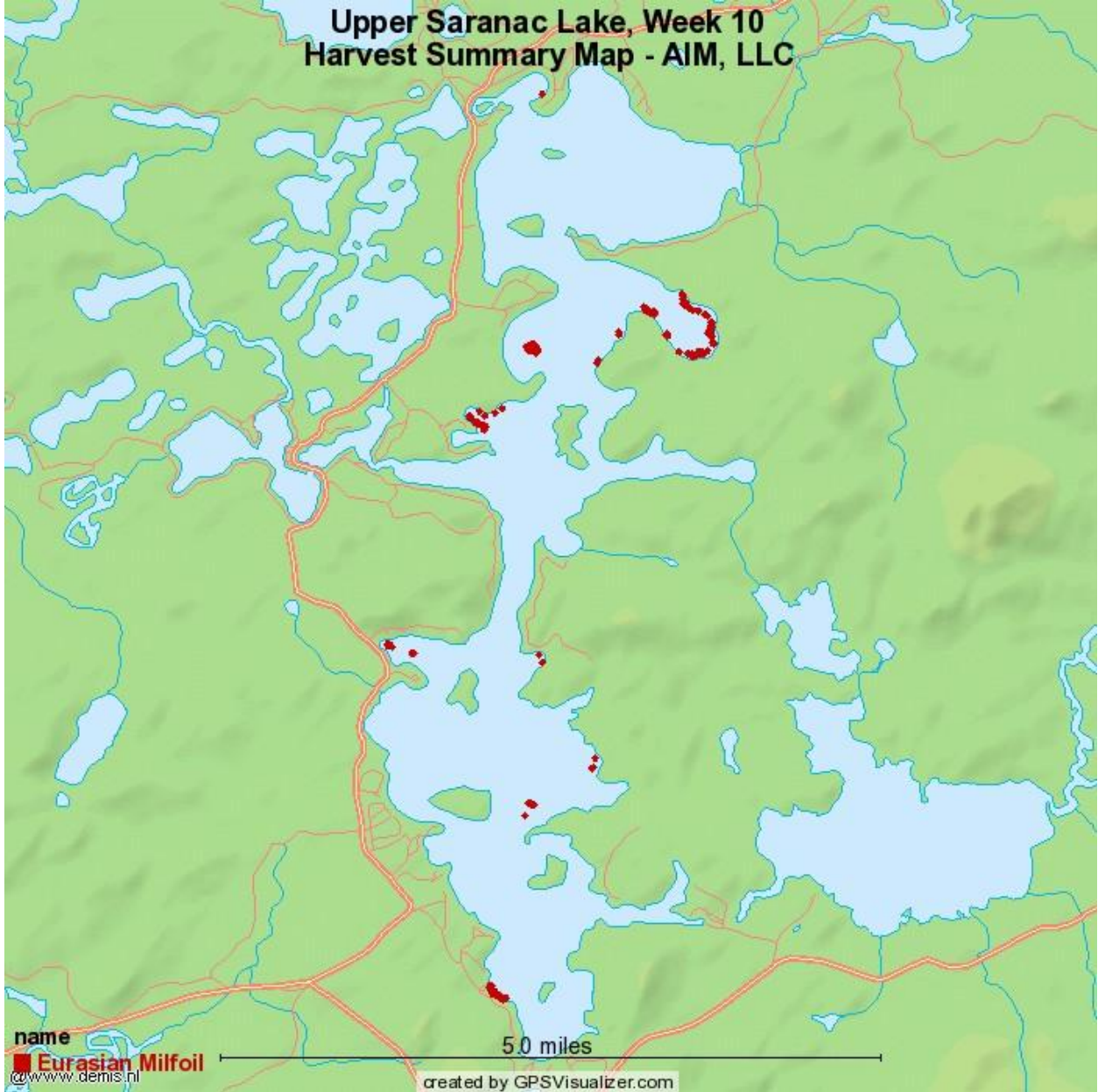
Took care of several new buoy locations reported by Guy including the Gilpin Bay rockpile (16 plants), shore in-between North and South Gull Bays (3-5 plants) and two locations in Birch Bay. Then proceeded to Little Square and began line-swimming on the tongue. Large, 4-6' tall plants were found with single and multiple stems for a total of 2 bags.

Continued heavy picking in Little Square finding more 4-7' tall plants with 1-3 stems. Also took care of a few buoys dropped by Guy in Back Bay, Square Bay and the shore South of Square Bay. (1 3/4 bags pulled all but a few plants in Little Square).

Total Invasive plants removed: 5 bags 125 pounds

Little Square Bay will receive immediate attention next week with a continuation of the full-coverage swimming of the tongue and other areas of the bay. As usual, this area is proving to be a very productive growth culture for milfoil. We will see what it yields next week and make recommendations if we see a need to change strategy there.
