The crew began the week with a swim of the “tongue” in Little Square Bay finding 1 bag of small plants after a complete line swim of the entire area. They then removed 5 small, scattered plants from the area in front of Sekon and about 12 plants from the area in front of the boathouse at the Point. They swam the large bassweed patch in the North Basin removing 42 plants. The crew then moved to the divot south of Square Bay and worked into and all the way around Square Bay finding about 15 plants in the divot and 1 bag of plants in the entirety of Square Bay. They then started swimming from just North of Pork Bay into Saginaw Bay removing a patch of 62 plants just north of Pork. The crew finished the week with a swim of the West side of Eagle Island finding a few small patches producing 73 plants total and a swim of Gilpin Bay finding 65 plants. The vast majority of all harvested plants were clearly young, new growth indicating that our harvesting efforts are now staying on top of the re-emergent growth.
