



AIM Harvest Summary: Week of 7/9/12

Removed 40 plants from the elongated bassweed patch in south Pelky Bay. Removed 7 plants from the north shore of Green Island located near Guy's buoys (2). Removed 20 plants from the North Basin near Guy's buoys (8). Removed 35 plants from the channel between Buck Island and the Mainland near buoys (8). Saginaw Bay: Removed 140 plants from area near the small north central island and 90 plants removed from the end of the bay. Guy's buoys were scattered throughout Saginaw, we swam just about the entire bay over the next couple days except for the northwest section.

The morning was spent in Fish Creek Pond participating in Invasive Species Week, removed 5 plants from bay near the bridge. Removed 650 plants from the south shore of Saginaw Bay, half of these plants were found in a bassweed patch near a small cliff face close to the southern mouth of the Bay while the rest were dispersed randomly and in small patches along the southern shore.

Returned to large patch found the previous day and removed 60 additional plants. Removed 300 plants from the mouth of Saginaw just west of the 3 shallow water buoys near the mouth of Bay. Removed 35 plants from the southwest part of Pork Bay near Guy's buoys (2). Removed 210 plants from the northern shore and north-central bassweed patch in Bottle Bay.

Removed 15 plants from mixed vegetation patch near the dam. Removed 45 plants from small cove at the northernwest mouth of Bartlet Bay. Removed 35 plants from channel between Birch Island and mainland near buoys (8). Removed 35 plants from small cove to the southeast of Doctor's Island.

Plants found were a mix of young recently established plants and larger mature plants.
