



Brant Lake Milfoil Project: Weekly Summary, week of 6/25

The dive team started their swim of the lake at the Brant Lake Camp heading North and conducting a full swim of all concern areas counter-clockwise around the shore. By the end of the week the crew had reached the small bay South of the Brant Lake Camp thereby completing a full swim of the lake's productive milfoil areas. As usual the areas in the North End near Mark Lustik's house were productive. The North end of the rockpile in Sunset Cove also had about 100 plants growing. Very few Curly-leaf pondweed plants were found. The levels of growth found and harvested were all indicative of maintenance phase level harvesting. Once again this is all good news and a sign that things are working well on the lake.

Unless otherwise indicated all "plants removed" refers to Eurasian milfoil
